TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE AD HOC TECHNICAL EXPERT GROUP ON A GLOBAL MULTILATERAL BENEFIT-SHARING MECHANISM

3. The Ad Hoc Technical Expert Group shall:

(b) Include experts selected on the basis of their expertise on the issues under consideration, and participants representing indigenous peoples and local communities and women;

This recommendation is put forward to ensure that women have a seat in such discussions that may have an impact on how policies are shaped and how their, gender specific perspectives could feed into a Global Multilateral Benefit Sharing Mechanism that addresses their access to fair and equitable sharing of befits derived from the utilization of genetic resources and their traditional knowledge associated with genetic resources that occur in transboundary situations.

We look for Party support for our recommendations.
